

Ankeny Area Quilters' Guild Spring Challenge – May 9, 2006

Categories: 1. First time ever completing a guild challenge
Pieced item – no appliqué
Mixed techniques – combining appliqué and piecing

Rules: 1. This challenge is open only to current members of the Ankeny Area Quilters' Guild.

Members choose the category in which their project will be judged.

One numbered challenge packet with 1 fat quarter and instructions must be purchased for each entry. Cost is \$2.50

The perimeter of the item must measure at least 40 inches and no more than 120 inches. Each entry will be measured to assure that it is within the range listed above.

A recognizable amount of the “challenge” fabric(s) must be used on the front of your item.

The item must be completed entirely by the member. This means that the member submitting the challenge item must do the piecing, appliqué, quilting, binding, embellishing, etc.

The item must be finished.

More Information:

1. An unlimited number of additional fabrics may be used.

Entries may be embellished as desired.

Any design or pattern is acceptable.

Prizes will be awarded in each category with winners determined by vote of members present at the May 9, 2006 meeting.

Prizes in each category – 1st place -\$40, 2nd place- \$30, 3rd place -\$20.

One \$25 gift certificate will be awarded to the entry voted to have the most creative interpretation of the challenge theme

Entry Instructions:

Finished entries are to be brought in a plain brown paper bag to the May 9, 2006 guild meeting.

The number provided with your challenge fabric packet is to be pinned to the front of the entry for judging purposes.

Please use masking tape to cover your name/label on the back of the quilt.
