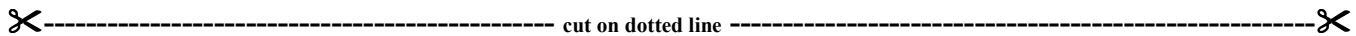

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**RULES AND ENTRY FORM INSTRUCTIONS**

### ENTRY FORM INSTRUCTIONS

**Section 1** - Complete **ALL** information. If you do not have a phone number, email address, etc., enter N/A.

**Section 2** - Complete **ALL** information. The name of the entry, who pieced it, and who quilted it will be included on the display tag that will be attached to the quilt for the public to read. All entries must be measured in inches. The length (top-to-bottom measurement) and width (side-to-side measurement) and total perimeter must be completed in this section. See Measuring An Entry below for complete instructions. The Wearable category is the only category where the length, width and total perimeter are not required in this section. If an entry is a 2006 Challenge Quilt, check the box, as this will be indicated on the display tag, too.

**Section 3** - Entrant's must indicate which category each entry best fits. **CHECK ONLY ONE CATEGORY.** If an entry meets the requirements for more than one category, choose just one. The AAQG Quilt Show Committee reserves the right to change a selected category if the entry does not meet category guidelines. Guidelines for each category are as follows:

**Large Pieced** - quilts measuring 280 inches or more in perimeter  
**Small Pieced** - quilts measuring 101 inches to 279 inches in perimeter  
**Large Appliqué** - quilts measuring 280 inches or more in perimeter  
**Small Appliqué** - quilts measuring 101 inches to 279 inches in perimeter  
**Miniature** - quilts measuring 100 inches or less in perimeter  
**Mixed Technique** - quilts constructed using two or more different techniques - No perimeter limitations  
**Original Art** - the design of the quilt is an original design of the entrant's - No perimeter limitations  
**Wearable Art** - quilted clothing, purses, tote bags, etc. - At least 50% of the item must be quilted - No size limitations  
**Start to Finish** - the entry must be pieced and quilted by the entrant - No perimeter limitations  
**Novice** - Reserved for the quilter who has been quilting for less than 2 years from the date of the show - No perimeter or size limitations

**Section 4** - Each display tag will have room to include a brief description of the entry. Why you made it, what inspired you, whom it may be for, why you chose the color choice you did, is it an original design, etc. The display tags contain a lot of information so we ask that you limit your description to 50 words or less. The AAQG Quilt Show Committee reserves the right to edit your description if the need arises.

#### Measuring An Entry

Measure length (one long side) and width (one end) separately. Round to the nearest inch.

If your measurement is .5 inches or greater, round up.

If your measurement is less than .5 inches, round down.

**For example: 102 1/4 " would be 102". 89 3/4" would 90 ".**

Enter the length and width on entry form.

**For example: 102 X 90**

For Total Perimeter, measure each side separately using the rounding process mentioned above. Add all four sides together to get the total perimeter. Enter this on the entry form.

#### QUILTFEST 2006 AWARDS

Our show is not judged. The voting public determines all awards. The Quilt Show Chair, Chair-Elect and three (3) randomly selected Quilt Show committee members will tally all votes. **ALL awards will be presented during the AAQG August 2006 meeting.**

Viewer's Choice - Viewer's Choice Award

In addition to the Viewer's Choice Award, Awards will be given for all 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> Place winners in each of the 10 categories.

**The bottom portion of the entry form (see other side) should be cut away and attached to your quilt when you hand it over for display. This information MUST be completed, put into a zip lock bag, and securely attached to the BACK of your entry in the BOTTOM LOWER RIGHT-HAND CORNER.**

### RULES

You must be a current AAQG member to enter. Entries from non-members will be disqualified and will not be displayed.

No late or incomplete entry forms will be accepted. **No entry will be accepted without entrant's signature and date on the entry form.**

All entries must be entered in the name of the maker.

Entries must not have been displayed in a previous AAQG Quilt Show.

All entries must be clean, free of straight pins, constructed of fabric, quilted, and finished. Soiled quilts will not be displayed.

All entries must contain the bottom portion of the entry form in a zip lock bag and secured on the **back** in the **lower right-hand corner**.

AAQG will take every reasonable precaution to protect entries exhibited in this show. AAQG is not responsible for acts of nature and other acts beyond their control.

All entries will be displayed to the public between the hours of 9 AM - 6 PM on Friday and 9 AM - 4 PM on Saturday.

You will be responsible for delivery and pick-up of all items you enter. A designated person picking up your entry(s) must have a signed statement from you.

Entries may be dropped off at Quilter's Cupboard, 131 N Ankeny Blvd., Ankeny, IA during store hours beginning July 1 and ending **July 6 until NOON ONLY** or you may bring them to the Faith Baptist Bible College between 11 AM and NOON on July 6.

Entries must be picked up between 4:15 PM and 5:15 PM on Saturday, July 8. **ENTRIES MAY NOT BE PICKED UP BEFORE 4:15 PM ON SATURDAY.** Be sure to read the May and June 2006 AAQG Newsletters for more details on pick-up instructions.
